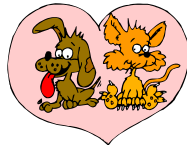


Will you help?

- Beef and turkey dogs (for training)
- Cheese for dog training, including thick-sliced Gouda and Munster
- Bleach
- Wet (pate) dog food
