The Saint Andrew Home and School Association is proud to offer our students in grade 3 through 8 an opportunity to serve others in our greater community on Martin Luther King Day, January 21, 2019. Our inaugural *Day of Service* will be held in Monsignor McGettigan Hall from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. The program will involve an Opening Prayer Service followed by dedicated working stations where students will engage in hands-on activities to support Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, Animal Providence Center, Lisa's Army and local food shelters. In addition, our students will recognize the efforts of our local first responders and create rosary beads for missionary work around the world. As another avenue to support local partners in our mission, there will be dedicated drop-off sites throughout the venue for donations to support our Saint Andrew Parish Food Pantry, our Archdiocese of Philadelphia Schools of Special Education and Animal Providence Center. Included in this packet of information is a ***student permission slip, information regarding our MLK Poster Contest and ways to help us secure much needed supplies.***

Our first Day of Service, to celebrate the message of Martin Luther King and build community within our School, allows all families the ability to meaningfully participate. Here are some simple ways to ensure success in year one:

- Attend our first Day of Service on January 21, 2019. Student permission slips are due on January 14th,
- Participate in the MLK Poster Content. All submissions are due on January 14th and judging will take place among peers at the Day of Service programs,
- Donate station supplies (see enclosed flyer) and drop off to the Main Office during school business hours,
- Help us provide needed supplies for three community partners through our donation drop-off boxes in the lower and upper school: new books for the Schools of Special Education in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, clean, gently used towels and blankets for Animal Providence Center and canned food supplies for the Saint Andrew Parish food pantry.

Our success depends upon the continued support of both our school families and surrounding community partners. Thank you in advance for your on-going support of our efforts. We hope to see your student(s) on January 21st!
